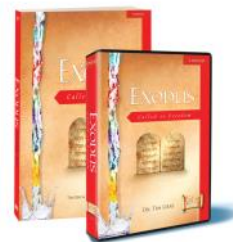
## Exodus: A Great Adventure Bible Study

- Learn how a proper understanding of the Exodus event can illuminate your understanding of the Christian Faith.



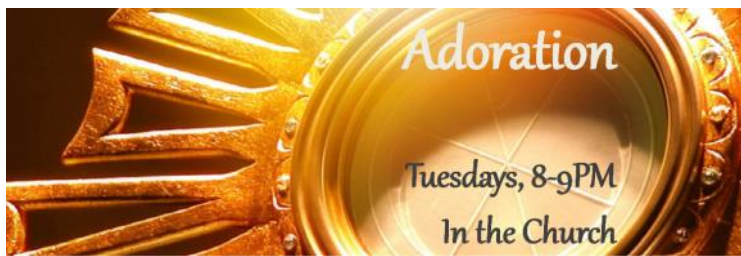

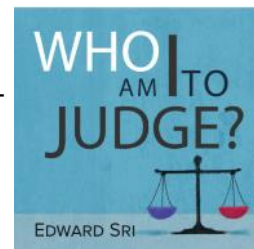
