Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Recently I started offering my priestly services of confession and spiritual direction to the inmates in Solano County. Twice I have visited our incarcerated sisters in Christ and it has been an eye opening and graced experience. As the women come into the room where we meet, there is a jail house swagger in their walk and a hardness in their facial expression. However, once we start talking and they pour out their souls to God, a beautiful transformation occurs right in front of my eyes. These women, many of whom are battle tested, soften and drop their jail house personas. Previously unemotional eyes fill with tears, remorse over sinful and criminal actions is evident, and true sorrow for sins and the pain of being separated from loved ones comes from the heart. After I say the words of absolution, these "hardened criminals" smile and become childlike when I explain to them they are daughters of God, loved by God and freed them from their sins. Let us pray for all the incarnated and their victims, that all may find the healing love of Jesus Christ.

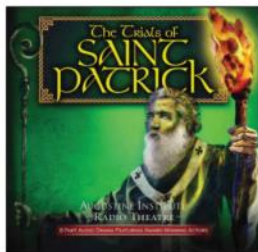
