On this last day of my work in the St. Dominic's office, I just wanted to take this time to thank you all for your love and support over the last 4 1/2 years. From the first time I shared my deeply personal story during a 7 Last Words Reflection or my family testimony during the One Campaign Town Hall Meetings, you met me with an embrace that led to so many new friendships and opportunities for me to get involved here in St. Dominic's well beyond my professional position.

I have never had the opportunity to put more of myself into my job than here at St. Dominic's. It has made all the difference in the effort that I put in on a daily basis to get the best result for this community and the mission of the Church.

In this New Evangelization, I am really proud that we were able to push the boundaries of the communications you expect from your church. Some of the changes took time to adjust to, a new logo and new website and moving more of our content and photos online, but you embraced it all and engaged at a new level. We've seen our online community grow from just 40 Facebook followers to over 1400 and our website is visited by over 20,000 individuals annually, well beyond our community.






