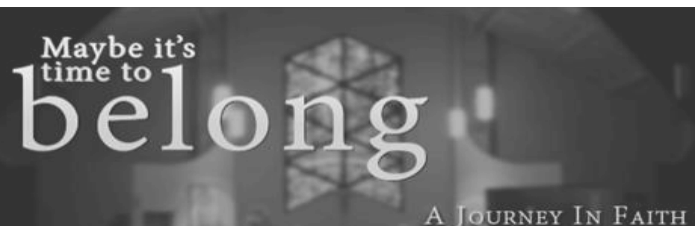

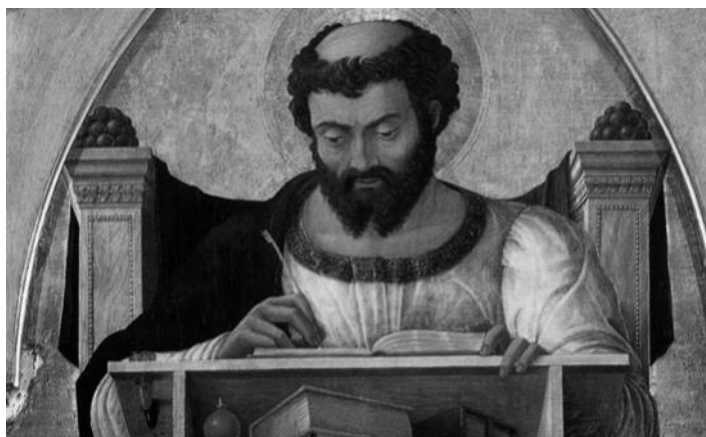

Understanding Luke's theology exclusively through his Gospel

This course (presented in Spanish only) offers an excellent overview of the theology present in the Sunday readings of this Gospel during Year C (the liturgical year that begins in December). There is a great deal of narrative and teachings of Jesus that are unique to Luke among the four canonic gospels. These texts provide a concise vision of the theological intention of the evangelist.

### **Themes of the 5 session:**

- ♦ **October 30th:** An introduction of the themes of the Gospel of Luke
- ♦ **November 6th:** The narratives of the infancy of Christ in Luke.
- ♦ **November 13th:** The parables of Luke.
- ♦ **November 20th:** Episodes at the Table in Luke.
- ♦ **December 4th:** The passion of Christ in Luke.
