Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last weekend was one of those weekends that when I put my head on my pillow Sunday night I said, "I love being a priest." The weekend started on Saturday with a funeral for Seb, who died at 100 vears old! The death of a loved one is never easy but when the person is 100 and a man of God, I think we can all say it was time. Then in the afternoon I witnessed the marriage vows of Katrina and David, a wonderful couple who are starting their married life together. After the 7:30 Sunday Mass, I had the privilege of saying the nuptial blessing from the marriage rite over Doanh and Hau who were celebrating 52 years of married life together. At the 10:45 Mass, I had the honor of baptizing Danicamarie, all of three months old, into the Catholic faith. It was my turn on the preaching rotation, so I preached at all six Sunday Masses. If that was not enough, God sent a lost Catholic sheep who has been away for decades to talk to me and a Protestant who wanted to know more about the Catholic understanding of the Eucharist. Wow! God is good. However, I didn't win the Megamillions billion plus dollar grand prize, so I am a little mad at God for that.

I recently read a book entitled, "The Language of God: A Scientist Presents Evidence for Belief" by Francis S. Collins. The author became an atheist in his youth and went on to become a worldrenowned scientist. In fact, Mr. Collins is a physician/ geneticist who discovered the genes associated with a number of diseases, which led the Human Genome Project. He is currently the director of the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Maryland. This is a real smart guy. Along the way Mr. Collins rediscovered his Christian faith. His book is his understanding of how faith and science complement each other. Mr. Collins acknowledges that both disciplines have their expertise and limitations, and can learn from each other if they are intellectually honest. I really like his six principles of theistic evolution that I believe, believers and scientists can agree upon regarding the guestion of evolution. He also has a really clever way of rectifying the Big Bang theory, given to us by the Catholic priest Georges Lemaître, and Free Will, given to us by God. It is worth a read. After, of course, you have finished your homework from last weekend's homily, which was to read the Letter to the Hebrews from your Bible!




