





40 DAYS FOR LIFE is off to a great start! The Respect Life Ministry here at St. Dominic's is always looking for new members. If you are interested in sharing your story or participating in this ministry, please email them to find out more information.

Society places limitations on how individuals should be treated, based on their perceived value. Pope Francis calls these limitations the "throwaway culture," a culture that discards individuals when they are no longer deemed to be living lives of usefulness.

This happens too often; whether it is an unborn child diagnosed with a disability, a prisoner on death row, an elderly person that cannot live independently, or an individual fighting terminal illness. The throwaway culture believes everything can be disposed of or replaced.

The Catholic Church's message of love, however, challenges this notion. At the Last Supper, Jesus gave his disciples a new commandment: "As I have loved you, so you also should love one another" (John 13:34). This message is central to the faith, calling all to respect one another as people loved by God.
