Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I know today starts the season of Advent when we prepare for the birth of Our Lord Jesus Christ. I also know it is the season of shopping and gift giving. A number of years ago, I stopped giving gifts to my nephews and nieces. I did this because at one Christmas they got more toys and gifts than they would use in a lifetime. Instead of giving them gifts, when I go home after Christmas I take them out for the day. Weather depending, we go to the park, zoo, or a child friendly museum. There is always a trip to their favorite eatery. I hope they have not outgrown the Dawg House because it makes killer hot dogs.





To celebrate the beginning of the Christmas Season, the Holy Family Choir from Rutherford will be presenting a service of Carols & Lessons here at St. Dominic's on the First Sunday of Advent **December 2nd at 7:30pm**.

This is the fifth year the Holy Family Choir has presented the Carols and Lessons service at various parishes around the North Bay. Please come and enjoy it with us. The service includes an opening and closing prayer, and nine short Scripture readings, from Genesis to the Gospel of John. Between the readings there will be Christmas motets sung by the choir and familiar carols for the congregation and choir to sing together.

Lessons and Carols is an English tradition dating to King's College, Cambridge, in 1918. December 2nd is the First Sunday of Advent, the official beginning of the Christmas season. It's a start on getting ready for Christmas, a way to go caroling without getting cold and wet, and, the choir hopes, a bit of a cultural up-tick from Christmas Musak in the shopping mall.
