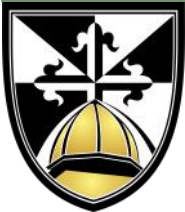

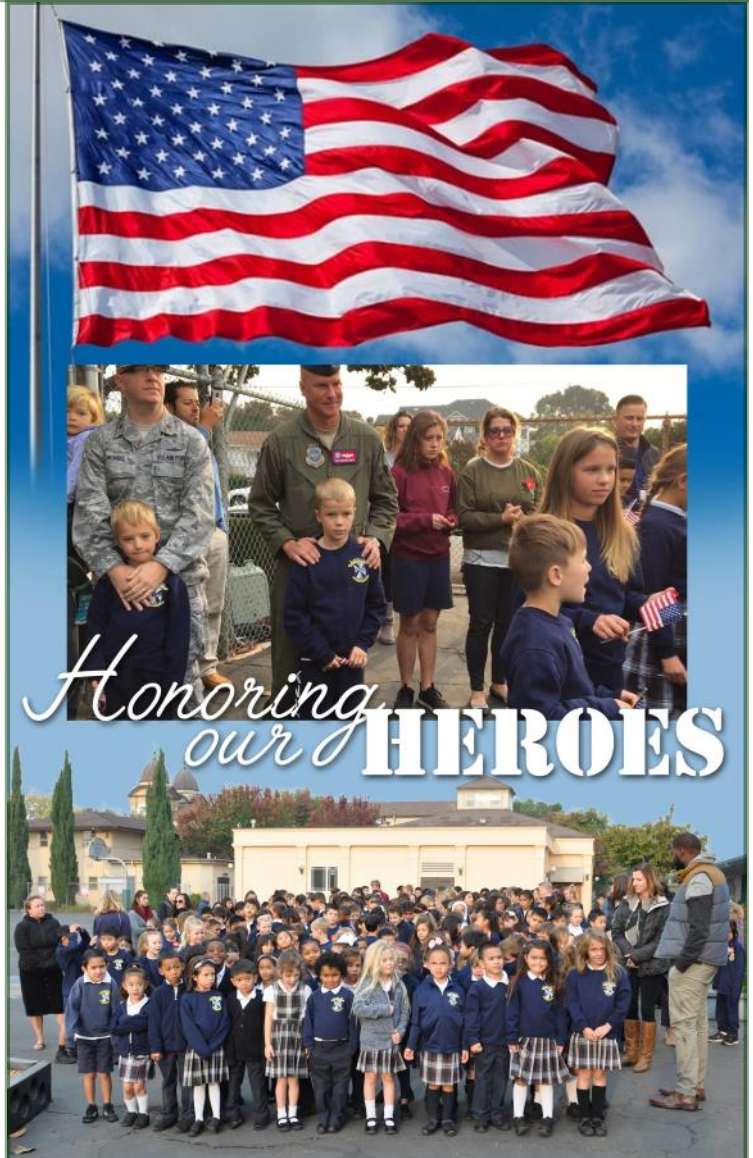

## Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

To get into the spirit of Halloween in October I read a book entitled, "The Demon of Brownville Road" by Bob Cranmer and Erica Manfred. This book recounts the demonic infestation (possession) of a house purchased by the Cranmer family and their struggle to exorcise the house. Mr. Cranmer recounts how as a youth he was drawn to this house, and when the opportunity to purchase it later in life was presented, he happily did so. Well, one must be careful what he wishes for. It turns out the land the house was built upon and the house itself has a very dark past. Unsettled human souls (ghosts) and a very powerful demon also reside in the house. Mr. Cranmer details the various manifestations of evil, their effects on the Cranmer family, and the spiritual battles to free their house of all supernatural residents. The book is not a Hollywood, sensationalized page-turner to entertain the reader. Rather, the book looks at the causes of evil, the reality of demons and ghosts, and the spiritual solutions for liberation. If you are looking for a sober yet realistic look at things that go bump in the night, give "The Demon of Brownville Road" a read. If you have trouble sleeping at night after reading it, do not blame me.

Every year the diocese asks all the parishes of the diocese to take censuses two weekends in the month of October. The chart (below and to the right) shows the census for the last four years. Looking at the numbers, we have pretty much maintained an average of 1,550 parishioners each weekend. This number is the average minus 10/25/2015. That weekend all the children and families in our various religious education programs were invited (mandated...cough, cough) to the 5:00 pm Mass, and we had 454 people attend that Mass alone. So, the numbers were a little skewed that weekend. Being in my sixth year as your pastor, we have buried lots of people, families have moved away, and, let's be honest, some people don't like me and have moved on in protest. That being said, people constantly introduce themselves to me after Mass and say they are new to the parish. "The LORD gave and the LORD has taken away." While it is not a numbers game, there are still some empty spaces in our pews, so feel free to invite friends and neighbors to join us for Mass.

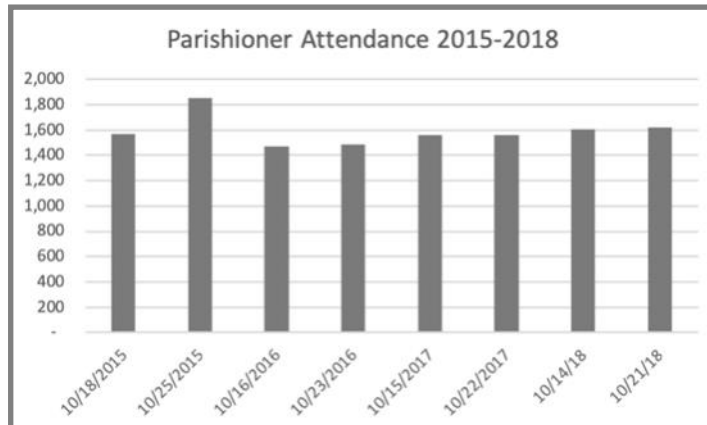

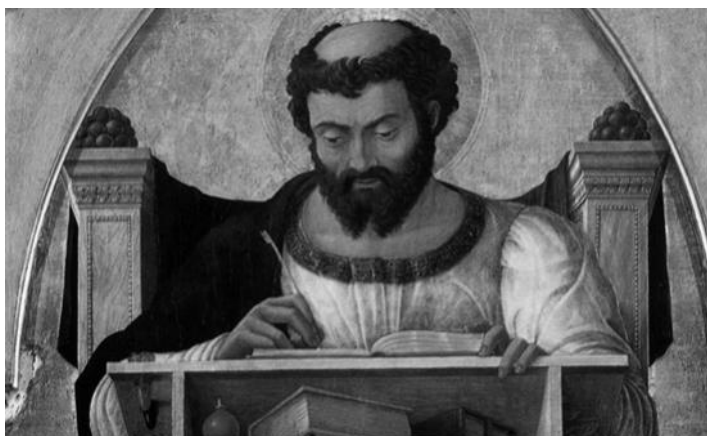

**Blessed** is a supplemental text intended to stay in the home as means to support the ageless art of bedtime storytelling between parent and child. **Blessed** is special because it captures the genius of biblical storytelling in a way that fans the flames of a child's imagination of who they are in God's sacred story for all of God's People. The necessity for homebased storytelling is based on two basic understandings. The first understanding is that parents are *the* authoritative storytellers in the eyes of their children. As such, the proper place for sacred storytelling is rightfully in the child's home among those most known, trusted and loved.

The second understanding is that children who have first heard the Word of God from a place of love in the home will be better disposed to understand the sacred story in the classroom in the hands of a religious education teacher who can give the sacred story its larger context and meaning. The Office of Faith Formation asks for your prayers for the children of our faith community who are preparing for their First Reconciliation and First Communion.

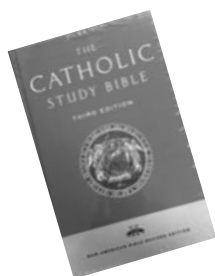
