Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It's a Lenten miracle! As you know, I went home a week ago, for a week, to give a mission at my parents' parish. The same mission I gave yesterday here at St. Dominic's. In the seven days I was in New Jersey and New York I did not eat one piece of pizza or bagel. When I told my parents, I was not eating pizza or bagels as part of my Lenten practices, they replied, "What are we going to feed you!?" I also lost five pounds over the week. Confirmation of adults is offered twice a year in our diocese. The next Confirmation Mass will take place on the Vigil of Pentecost, Sat. June 8, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament.

This special Mass is for adults who were baptized in the Church, received First Holy Communion and have been regularly attending Mass, but were never confirmed. Those who have not received First Holy Communion and have not been attending Mass regularly should be treated as candidates in the RCIA process.

It is the parish's responsibility to prepare candidates for Confirmation based on the four pillars of the Catechism, with a special emphasis on the rites of initiation. Candidates should receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before Confirmation.


