Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Christ is Risen! He is Risen indeed!" This exchange is the Paschal greeting Christians have traditionally used during the Easter season. The Biblical warrant comes from the Gospel of Luke 24:34, "The Lord has truly been raised and has appeared to Simon!" The context of the verse is the encounter with Jesus Christ on the Road to Emmaus. Two disciples of Jesus have just encountered the Risen Christ and are bringing the Good News of the Resurrection to the other disciples. When the two arrive they recounted their experiences of the Risen Christ. It is also recorded that when Mary Magdalene met with Emperor Tiberius in Rome her greeting to him was, "Christ is Risen." Thus, from antiquity the reality of Jesus Christ rising from the dead was on the lips and hearts of believers.

The words "He is risen!" reminds us of the Good News we proclaim at Easter; Jesus' death was not in vain and that He has the power to overcome sin and death. Saying "He is Risen!" allows us to share this incredible truth with others. So, please say it loud and proud!

Thank you to all those who worked so hard during Lent, the Triduum and our Easter liturgies to make them such grace filled events. All our soup suppers, Stations, penance services, cleaning, singing, reading, ushering and so many other outpourings of your generosity are greatly appreciated. St. Dominic's is very much alive in the Risen Christ.

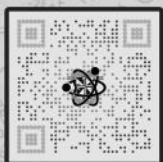
