

Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

A New, New Pastor at St Dominic's



Let me start by saying I, Fr. Jerome, am still heading to St. Raymond's Church. However, Fr. Carl Schlichte, O.P. will be the new pastor here at St. Dominic's in July. So, what happened?

After all the assignments were made for this next ministerial year, the priest who was supposed to go to St. Dominic's Church in Los Angeles asked the province to allow him to discern becoming a diocesan priest. This means for the next three years he will minister as a diocesan priest. After that time, if the diocese and he agree diocesan priesthood is where God is calling him, he will leave the Dominicans and become a diocesan priest. While this would be a loss for the Western Dominican Province, the larger Catholic Church benefits.

Fr. Roberto Corral, O.P., who was supposed to be the next pastor here at St. Dominic's, was acting as the interim pastor at St. Dominic's Church in Los Angeles. Therefore, the province has asked Fr. Roberto to stay in Los Angeles and be the next pastor down there.

Because of Fr. Roberto staying in Los Angeles, the province has assigned Fr. Carl to be the next pastor here at St. Dominic's. Fr. Carl will be preaching all the Masses next weekend, May 11th & 12th. At that time, you will be able to meet and welcome him to Benicia. Fr. Carl will begin his term as pastor at St. Dominic's on July 1st.



The Easter Season

Good Shepherd Sunday

We continue our journey through the Easter Season – the “One Great Sunday.”

Today we explore briefly why next Sunday, the fourth Sunday of Easter, is called “Good Shepherd Sunday.”

Historically, “Good Shepherd Sunday,” was celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter. The day received its name from the many images in the tenth chapter of the gospel of John that is proclaimed on this weekend. As the pattern of the lectionary developed and we came to acknowledge that in the early weeks of Easter we read about accounts where Jesus appeared to the disciples, Good Shepherd Sunday was shifted to the fourth Sunday of Easter so we can hear all the appearance accounts together as a group. Each year of our lectionary cycle the image of the shepherd changes slightly. This weekend, we read in the Gospel that Christ is seen as the sheepgate through which authentic pastors and sheep pass. The image of the gate is one that is a dividing line between the threats of the outside world and the safety of the meadow and the sheepfold. In year B, Christ is the shepherd who guides, protects, and cares for his sheep. In year C, the gospel we will hear next weekend, the response of the sheep to the shepherd’s lead is emphasized. Sometimes this Sunday is called a “hinge” Sunday in that we are making a shift in our thought process during the Easter season. The image of the compassion and care of the Good Shepherd calls us to look back with fondness to the appearance accounts of Jesus that we have heard in previous weeks. We are also challenged to look ahead in preparation to our call to become disciples which we will hear about in the upcoming weeks of the season. The message of the Gospel today gives us hope as we learn more about being a disciple. Jesus, the Good Shepherd said, “Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture....I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly.” As we look ahead to the ups and downs of discipleship, Jesus reminds us that he is always walking ahead of us to protect us and to guide us.

On Good Shepherd Sunday, may we go forth and bring to life the words of Henry W. Baker, “The king of love my Shepherd is, whose goodness fails me never; I nothing lack if I am his, and he is mine forever.....Good Shepherd, may I sing your praise within your house forever.”
