TRINITY SUNDAY

The two weeks immediately following the celebration of Pentecost hold special importance in the life of the Church. This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The following weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ also known as Corpus Christi Sunday. This week we examine the celebration of the Trinity.

Although the celebration of the Trinity was originally resisted by Rome, several elements of the feast predate its formal institution in 1334. Special emphasis on the Trinity was emphasized during the fourth and fifth centuries in liturgies and different pravers when the "Arian" heresy swept through the Church. The core of the heresy was that it denied that Jesus was equal to God. Despite the fact that many communities celebrated the feast of the Trinity; the sentiment was not shared by the Popes of the time. Pope Alexander II is reported to have said that no particular day should be devoted to a feast about the Blessed Trinity since its commemoration is celebrated every Sunday and even daily. Subsequent Popes also opposed this feast. Yet in 1251, after visiting the Trinity Church in Krahan, Pope Innocent IV authorized an indulgence of 400 days for observing the feast. Synods around the world quickly authorized the feast in their areas. Finally in 1334 during his exile in Avignon, Pope John XXII approved the feast and extended it to the whole church.

Trinity Sunday is known as an "idea feast" since it honors not an event in salvation history but a particular aspect of doctrine in the Church. Reforms in the liturgy have reduced the number of idea feasts showing more preference for event-centered feast days. Trinity Sunday is one of nine solemnities remaining on our liturgical calendar today that are considered "idea" feasts.

One of the most common ways that we celebrate the doctrine of the Trinity is through the action of making the sign of the cross. The action of making the sign of the cross had no words attached to it for many years. As people became more educated about the concept of the Trinity, the words that we know so well were added, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." As we celebrate the Trinity, consider this thought of Father Richard Rohr. He contends that we must remember not "who" we are, but "whose" we are. In this simple action of making the sign of the cross we mark ourselves with God's insignia. It is an outward sign of our faith. The making of the sign of the cross reminds us of "whose" we are.
