# **Pastor's Corner**

What I'm doing for my summer vacation

Prior to my one-year assignment to St. Raymond last year, I had a wonderful sabbatical on the occasion of my 20th anniversary of ordination. I will tell more about it in future articles, but I want to focus on one piece.

St. Joseph's Abbey in Spencer, Massachusetts is a Trappist monastery. Frs. Thomas Keating and Basil Pennington are late, well-known members of that community; Fr. Thomas Merton was also a Trappist, but from Kentucky. St. Joseph's has what they call a Monastic Residency Program. It is open to any Christian man able and willing to commit 90 days to the abbey. It gives men the opportunity to taste the life of a monk: live in the cloister, attend all the divine office throughout the day - starting at 3:30 am (!), attend the weekly abbot's conference, eat, work, and do just about everything a member of the community does. As a priest, I was even invited to celebrate Mass and preach a few times. (It does not hurt that there are two former Dominicans in the community, one from the Western Province and one from the East, so the community is very Dominican-positive.)

It was a beautiful and profound experience. I have always had "monastic leanings," though not as strong as many younger members of the Order, so I was very attracted to the opportunity once I learned of it. It may sound ironic but living as a monk only confirmed my vocation as a Dominican. I profoundly appreciate the monastic vocation and I loved the deep prayer and simplicity of the daily routine, but there was definitely something missing: preaching and ministry.

I left the Abbev early to attend the funeral of one of my mentors in the Province, who was responsible for me being assigned to work with him at Stanford University's campus ministry, Fr. Patrick LaBelle. The monks understood perfectly why I had to leave, but they were also clear that I was to come back and "finish my time" as they put it. This summer is my first chance to do that. Originally, I was invited back for a month. That was the plan, but with my reassignment to be with you and other factors, a month was not possible. The abbot is graciously allowing me to come for two weeks. So that is where I will be going after Fr. Brad gets back from his home visit and Baby Priest, er Newly Ordained, gathering. I will be away July 22nd - August 5th, back just in time for St. Dominic's Feast Day Mass & Picnic!
