Pastor's Corner

Rosary Sunday is almost here!

Thank you, thank you, thank you! You are one of the most supportive communities we Western Dominicans serve, both personally and financially. Those of you who have been around a while, know that its "that" time of year. Rosary Sunday is next Sunday. It is the one time each year that we Dominicans are allowed to ask you for financial support for your future priests and brothers. I am particularly grateful to those who gave between 1990 & 1998, when I was in formation: you made my education and formation possible. Thank you!

Having had a number of Residency brothers, you have a unique opportunity to see your donations at work: Brother's Reports (short reflections at Sunday Mass), SDS and RE classroom visits, occasional talks to the whole parish, help with Confirmation preparation, presence before and after Mass, to name a few examples. You know that when it comes to the Student Brothers, each is unique. There is an old Roman saying: if you've met one Jesuit, you've met them all; if you've met one Dominican, you've met one Dominican. I mean no disrespect to the Society of Jesus, but if you put Fr. 
We depend on you to help us form our vibrant, young brothers. God continues to bless us with vocations, but we cannot form them by ourselves. We count first and foremost on your prayers for them, their professors, and those in charge of them. Please continue to keep them, especially the ones who have served here, in your prayers. Masses for the remainder of 2019 sold out early in September. This presents a problem when someone wants to offer a Mass for a recently deceased loved one, and the next available is three months away; if there is one available at all. Due to the limited number of Mass intentions offered each month, and the speed at which they sell out, we have a new Mass Intention Policy.

- Mass intentions will now open only ONE month in advance on the 1st. This means January 2020 Mass intentions will not be available until <u>December 1, 2019</u>. (February will open January 1, March will open February 1, etc.)
- Families will be limited to purchasing <u>three (3)</u> Mass intentions per month.

We hope this new policy will give everyone the same opportunity to have Mass said for their loved ones.

The Diocese of Sacramento is joining those in Los Angeles, Fresno, Orange, San Bernadino and San Diego in a program that brings compensation and justice to those who were sexually abused as minors by diocesan priests. All claims, regardless of how long ago they may have occurred, will be considered by the program. The ICP is independent, outside the control of any diocese. For more information, including how to submit a claim, please visit www.CaliforniaDiocesesICP.com. Let us always remember to pray for the victims of priest sexual abuse. As their pain is ongoing, so must our prayers for them be. If you are the victim of sexual abuse or suspect someone else has been abused: Contact law enforcement and make a report, then: If the perpetrator is a priest, deacon, seminarian or lay employee of the Diocese of Sacramento (the latter includes all parish and school staff), contact the Diocese toll-free at (866) 777-9133, or the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator (currently Loree Lippsmeyer) at (916) 733-0142; If the perpetrator is a member of the Western Dominican Province, call Fr. Carl, Fr. Brad, or the Provincial (our regional superior, currently Fr. Christopher Fadok, O.P.) at (510) 658-8722; If you are unsure if the perpetrator falls into the

above categories or simply do not want to make a second call, do not worry: law enforcement will investigate and will find the appropriate body to follow up with.
