All Saints and All Souls

Now that we have celebrated All Saint's Day on November 1st and All Soul's Day on November 2nd, we are reminded that Advent and Christmas are right around the corner. For many of us these celebrations are connected with Halloween and its ghouls, goblins, and creeping things of the night. However, entertaining this aspect of All Saint's Day and All Soul's Day,

there is a deeper, more spiritual reality that the Church draws our attention to on these celebrations: the power of intercessory prayer.

Intercessory prayer is prayer that we undertake for the sake of others. We "intercede" for them by offering our petitions for them to God. The catechism emphasizes that by praying for others in this way, we are made similar to Christ: "Intercession is a prayer of petition which leads us to pray as Jesus did. He is the one intercessor with the Father on behalf of all men, especially sinners. He is 'able for all time to save those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them." (CCC 2634). Thus, intercessory prayer is one of the best ways we have of growing as disciples of Jesus: the more we pray for others, the more we become like Jesus our Savior.

With the celebrations of All Saints Day and All Souls Day, there is a twofold instruction on the power of intercessory prayer: on the Feast of All Saints, we ask the saints in heaven to pray for us who still labor here on earth, while on the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed (All Soul's Day), we offer up our intercessory prayers for the souls of all the faithful departed who might need one last "push" of spiritual support to enter fully into eternal life. This need that the faithful departed have for our prayers teaches us about the Church's doctrine of purgatory: when faithful souls move on from this earthly existence, there is a final purification where the soul is made ready to enter into the infinitely holy presence of God. The saints in heaven have already made it through this purification, and rest securely in the presence of God for all eternity. For this reason, they can devote their energy to joining Christ in offering up their prayers for us who are still involved in the struggles of earthly life. For the faithful departed who are still undergoing this final purification, however, it is they who are in need of our prayers!

So, as we get ready for the holiday season, we enjoy a blessed exchange of intercessory prayer: on the Feast of All Saints, we ask the saints in heaven to offer their prayers for us, while on the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed, we offer our prayers for the departed souls still on their way to perfect blessedness. What a wonderful way to grow as a Church, following the example of Jesus Christ,
