Pastor's Corner

Who's your mamma?

One of the great privileges of my life was to care for my mother in her final months in this life. Her last gift to me was in many ways the greatest: she allowed this to happen and did so with her usual aplomb and grace. It wasn't easy and it certainly wasn't fun for either of us. The difficultly was not in the physical work (cooking, cleaning, monitoring medication, etc.), but in the role reversal, Regardless of the challenge, it was the best way I can imagine of manifesting my gratitude to this unique person. Was my service to her in any way, shape or form comparable to what she did for me? Absolutely not! But during the whole time, particularly when I was near (at or over) my wit's end. I often reminded myself that I was doing this out of love. For example, when cleaning up "accidents," I was mindful of the countless diapers of mine she changed. The reminder didn't make the task any more pleasant but kept my heart and mind in the right place.

The Old Testament has two unstated assumptions about maternal love. First, a mother's love for her children is stronger than any other one human being can have for another. Second, a mother's love is the best analogy for God's love for the human race. Genesis gives the first woman, Eve, the title "Mother of All the Living." (Gen. 3:20) The name "Eve" is etymologically related to the Hebrew verb "to live." All human life can be traced to our First Parents. Sarah is the mother of the Promise. She became the mother of the Chosen People even though she was far from childbearing age. She also disbelieved at first and laughed at the idea. Naomi loved and cared for her daughters-in-law, especially Ruth whose name is borne by the biblical book in which we hear of her, long past the time she was obliged or even expected to. Hannah was the mother of Samuel, the first prophet of Israel. She besought God for a child and gave him to God when her prayer was answered. God says through the prophet Isaiah, "as a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you." (Is. 66:13)

The New Testament has its share of important mothers. The mother of James and John seeks positions of importance for her sons in the Gospel of Matthew. In the city of Nain, Jesus "gave" a dead man to his mother, alive again, in Luke, just as the God the Father gave him to her when he was born. We also have the greatest mother presented to us in the Gospels: Mary. Later generations would call her the New Eve, because she is the mother of all the redeemed, and Champion Leader, because she is the first, the most powerful, and the most exemplary disciple. Not only did she give birth to Jesus after being overshadowed by the Holy Spirit, but Jesus gave her to us as he was dying on the cross: "Behold your mother." (John 19:27)

A Happy Mother's Day to all you moms and you who show a mother's love to others. Your gift is unparalleled and irreplaceable! Thank you for answering God's call to the vocation of motherhood! It is also a reminder to all of us to acknowledge and be grateful to the many women in our lives who are maternal figures. I hate to sound like a Jewish mother, but have you called, written or prayed for your mother lately?
