A prayer for the government

St. Paul said to Timothy, "First of all, then, I ask that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgivings be offered for everyone, for kings and for all in authority, that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all devotion and dignity. This is good and pleasing to God our savior, who wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth." (1 Timothy 2:1-3) The following pray was composed by Archbishop John Carroll, the first Catholic bishop and archbishop of the United States (Baltimore, MD) and was published on November 10, 1791. It was recited by all parishes throughout the territory. A happy 4th of July to one and all!

We pray, O Almighty and Eternal God, who through Jesus Christ have revealed Your glory to all nations: preserve the works of Your mercy, that Your Church, being spread through the whole world, may continue with unchanging faith in the confession of Your Name.

We pray You, who alone are good and holy: endow with heavenly knowledge, sincere zeal, and sanctity of life, our chief bishop Pope Francis, the Vicar of Our Lord Jesus Christ, in the government of His Church; our own bishop, Jaime Soto, all other bishops, prelates, and pastors of the Church; and especially those who are appointed to exercise among us the functions of the holy ministry, and conduct Your people into the ways of salvation.

We pray You O God of might, wisdom, and justice! Through whom authority is rightly administered, laws are enacted, and judgment decreed, assist with Your Holy Spirit of counsel and fortitude the President of these United States, that his administration may be conducted in righteousness, and be eminently useful to Your people over whom he presides; by encouraging due respect for virtue and religion; by a faithful execution of the laws in justice and mercy; and by restraining vice and immorality. Let the light of Your divine wisdom direct the deliberations of Congress, and shine forth in all the proceedings and laws framed for our rule and government, so that they may tend to the preservation of peace, the promotion of national happiness, the increase of industry, sobriety, and useful knowledge; and may perpetuate to us the blessing of equal liberty.

We pray for his Excellency, the governor of this state, for the members of the Assembly, for all judges, magistrates, and other officers who are appointed to guard our political welfare, that they may be enabled, by Your powerful protection, to discharge the duties of their respective stations with honesty and ability.

We recommend likewise, to Your unbounded mercy, all our brethren and fellow citizens throughout the United States, that they may be blessed in the knowledge and sanctified in the observance of Your most holy law; that they may be preserved in union, and in that peace which the world cannot give; and after enjoying the blessings of this life, be admitted to those which are eternal.

Finally, we pray to You, O Lord of mercy, to remember the souls of Your servants departed who are gone before us with the sign of faith and repose in the sleep of peace; the souls of our parents, relatives, and friends; of those who, when living, were members of this congregation, and particularly of such as are lately deceased; of all benefactors who, by their donations or legacies to this church, witnessed their zeal for the decency of divine worship and proved their claim to our grateful and charitable remembrance. To these, O Lord, and to all that rest in Christ, grant, we beseech You, a place of refreshment, light, and everlasting peace, through the same Jesus Christ, Our Lord and Savior. Amen.

Helpful Hints & Reminders For Mass

Thank you to all our parishioners for following these guidelines to help us to stay open.

- Bishop Soto Decree Dispensation dated 3/13/2020 releasing ALL faithful from obligation to attend Mass remains in effect.
- Please Stay Home With symptoms of sickness, fever, runny nose, trouble breathing & cough.
- 3. Masks are Mandatory As of 6/18/2020 Benicia & California Mandates masks for everyone over the age of 2
- Contract Tracing Names & numbers are collected at entrance for notification in the event someone is sick.
- 5. **Ushers/Greeters** Will seat you, usher you for Communion, and dismiss you please wait for them to signal you to go.
- 6. **30 minutes prior to Mass** Doors open and seating starts.
- Avoid Late Arrival Please be earlier than you normally would to ensure seating and less disruption to others already in Mass. Late arrivals could be turned away if seating is not available
- 8. **Household Seating** You may sit with those you live with. Please have your entire household unit together upon entering.
- 9. **RED Zone**: Do not sit in the center of the pew marked by red tape unless you are a family of 4 or more. This 6 ft section is to facilitate appropriate physical distancing.
- 10. No Switching Seats Once you have been seated please stay put. Pews must be cleaned and sanitized before we can seat someone else in the seat you left even if you don't touch anything.
- 11. **Church Capacity** Once capacity is reached for that Mass a sign will be placed on the door and no one else will be let in.
- 12. **Hand Sanitizer** Available upon entering and throughout the church.
- 13. **No Collection** Boxes mounted in the back for your envelopes and donations.
- 14. **No Printed Materials** Bulletins with worship aids available in our myParish app and online stdombenicia.org.
- 15. Sunday Mass Alternates by Last Name 1st letter of your last name determines which week you attend Mass. A-L and M-Z which will be on the bulletin each week.
