Brother's Corner

What is a parish? When we talk about what parish we attend, we typically refer to the Church you go to for Sunday. The hustle and bustle of parish life involves the administration of the sacraments, catechetical instruction and formation in the faith, various forms of ministries, and ultimately a community of believers that worship God are sanctified by Him. While this is true, there is more to it. Cardinal Raniero Cantalamessa, OFM. Cap, offers invaluable insights to the definition of a parish. In his book, titled *The Eucharist, our Sanctification*, he examines the use of the word "parish," (*paroikia* or *paroikos*) and parishioners" (*paroikoi*) in Sacred Scripture and letters written by the early Church Fathers. In the Acts of the Apostles (13:17), St. Luke refers to the life of the *sojourning* state of the people of Israel. In the Letter to the Hebrews (11:9), the author refers to Abraham as a *sojourner* or *exile* in a foreign land. Modern translations use the word *alien* or *exile* to express one's presence in a land that is not their homeland. But in reality, the word "parish" is more appropriate (... where they dwelt as *parishioners* in Egypt, Abraham lived a *parochial* life). In his second letter, St. Peter warns the *parishioners* to "abstain from the passions of the flesh" (cf. 2:11) and to "conduct themselves with fear in their *parochial* life" (cf. 1:17). This insight into the notion of the "parish" and "parishioner" conforms to a truer understanding of a Christian. It is not simply a "subdivision of a diocese" or "that which pertains to an administrative unit of a local church." It signifies a tangible reality; this fallen creation is not our true home. The early Church Fathers, like St. Clement and St. Polycarp, referred to God's Church as "*parochial*" when communicating with the early Christian communities. Christians, as early as the 2nd century, were identified as "alien[s] in a homeland who participate in everything like a citizen but bears with everything like a pilgrim" (Cantalamessa, 96). God created time, space, and creation to manifest and communicate His glory. Humanity exists in order to know the Trinity in unity. Jesus, who suffered, died, rose from the dead, broke the bond of sin and death from humanity did out love to bring us back to God. We are indeed foreigners in a strange land. Parishioners are "in the world but not of the world." "The world needs parishes that are places of pilgrimage and joy and not centers that offer all kinds of services, activities, and entertainments" (Cantalamessa, 98). As parishioners of a local parish, we are made to be in union with God in the heavenly Jerusalem. Parish churches should reflect, in their art, architecture, and music, the heavenly Jerusalem on earth as a foretaste of heaven. We, as parishioners of St. Dominic's, should continue to be a community of believers that bring the light of the Gospel to those within and those on the outskirts of our community with a greater zeal for our heavenly homeland.
