Important "announcements" from Monday Musings:

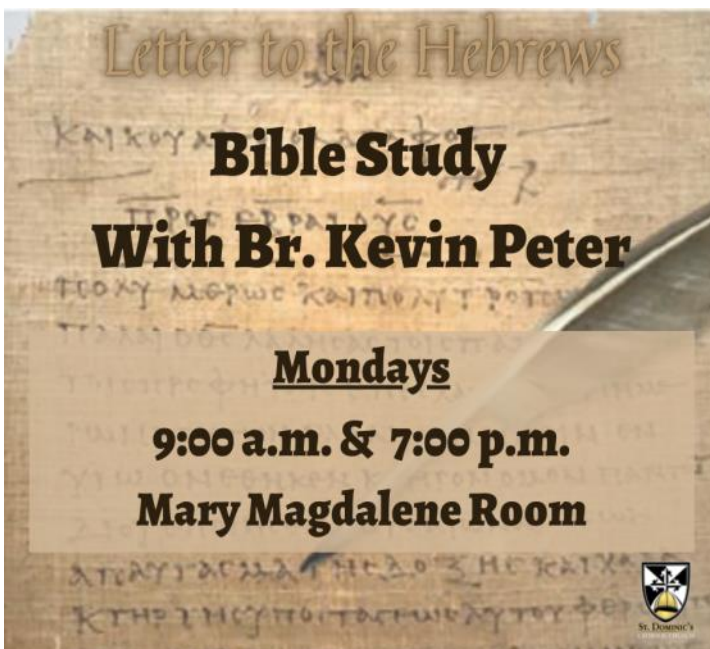
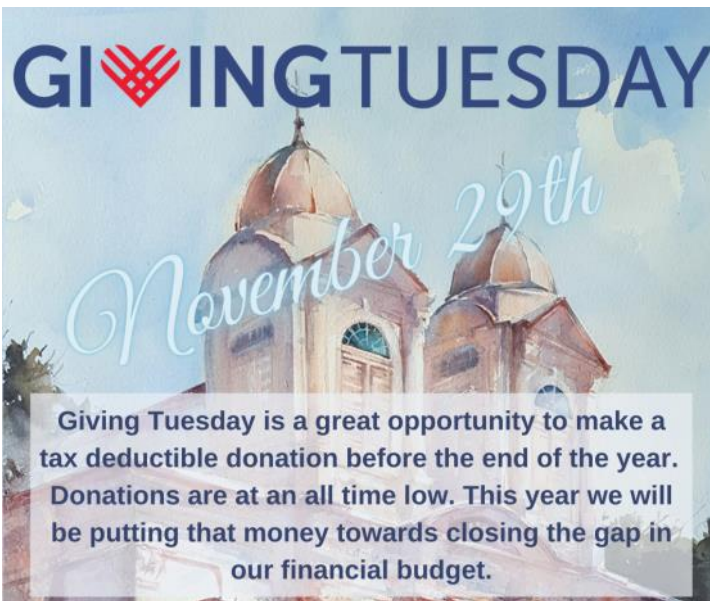
- ♦ **Mass time change from 7:00 to 7:30 a.m., Sunday morning, effective November 27, the 1st Sunday of Advent**
- ♦ Bishop Soto has lifted all COVID-related precautions from the Mass and the other sacraments effective immediately; we stopped praying the Pandemic Prayer at every Mass this past Tuesday
- ♦ The one pre-COVID restriction that remains in force is that the chalice will (still) not be distributed; the bishop will reconsider this next spring. (If you recall, Communion from the chalice was suspended at beginning of December 2019, the ramping up of cold and flu season that year.)
- ♦ Troy Killorn will not be coming to St. Dominic's as Music Director; he decided to stay at St. Catherine's. We will resume the search process for Francisco's successor. Please pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance in this process.

I will be away this weekend at the second West coast Life-Giving Wounds retreat at Vallombrosa Center in Menlo Park. The retreat runs from Friday evening until Sunday afternoon. This is a ministry to adult children of divorce. I found the retreat very moving and healing when I attended the first West coast retreat back in March. It was an incredible experience, for the first time in my life, to be in a room where everyone had the experience of being from a "broken home," and to share those wounds with others similarly wounded, and to see how the Lord Jesus had worked in their lives, and to highlight how He had worked in mine. I am really excited (as I write this) to see how the Lord is going to work in those attending this weekend. Please also pray that He will work through my talk, on the nature of Christian suffering, that I will give on Sunday morning. I am finding working with the Life-Giving Wounds community healing, invigorating, and deeply, spiritually, satisfying.

As we prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving this coming week, I invite you to reflect on how God has used your wounds to make you a means of healing grace to others, or how others have touched and helped to heal you by sharing their wounds or woundedness with you. Although it is certainly countercultural to think this way, we can be grateful for our wounds in as much as they are our personal, unique "access points" to Christ on the Cross, and our very intimate identification with Christ crucified. As St. Peter told us, "[Christ] himself bore our sins in his body upon the cross...By his wounds you have been healed." (1 Peter 2:24)
