

### **Brother's Corner**

Have you ever thought that holiness (sanctification, being holy, or however you want to say it) sounds really lame? If you have not, then perhaps I may take your place; I have. Particularly when I was a boy, but this even lasted into, at the very least, the beginning of adulthood. After all, being holy involves some combination of sitting quietly in Church, being nice to people instead of making incredibly witty jokes at their expense, and, most importantly, never having fun. Further, here we are in Advent, preparing for the birth of Jesus at Christmas, who is, apparently, here to make us holy and take away our fun.

Jn. 14:16: "Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." And what is involved in going to the Father, or, more simply, what does the Father want? 1 Peter sums it up nicely: "[A]s he who called you is holy, be holy yourselves in all your conduct; for it is written, 'You shall be holy, for I am holy." (1:15-16, referencing passages in Leviticus)

And what, exactly, does holiness entail? St. Paul gives us one example and a general precept: "For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you abstain from fornication; that each one of you know how to control your own body in holiness and honor[.]" (I Thess 4:3-4) From these passages, we can glean two things: first, that sanctification (holiness) means some kind of change taking place in the interior of the person. "Be holy, as I am holy." Second, there is such a thing as holiness in conduct, or actions; fornication, and not controlling your body in general, seems to be something that does not go with this state-of-being that God apparently wants of us.

What, then, is this state-of-being? We are generally familiar with the 10 Commandments, the virtues, and perhaps even the Beatitudes; but these are the actions of holiness, they are not holiness itself. What, then, is holiness?

To give some answer to this question, I am offering a three part series of talks in the leadup to Christmas, the 19th, 20th, and 23rd. The 19th will be: Advent, Christmas, and 'Deification,' or 'Holiness' (or: Becoming God, Without Being A Pantheist). The 20th will be: Advent, Christmas, and Your Call to the Contemplative Heights (Yes, You).' Finally, the 23rd will be: 'Advent, Christmas, and Your Life of Prayer As An Embodied Being United With An Incarnate God.'

"Holiness" or "Deification" is an absolutely amazing concept often misunderstood (and very much weakened), but it stands at the heart of our Christian life. I hope to cover and clarify what it actually means (talk 1); then to show how this spills forth to every Christian in a rich interior life (talk 2); and, finally, some concretization as to how this might look in each of our lives of prayer (talk 3). Attendance is *not* required at all three; you are welcome at any one or or two of the three, but it certainly is encouraged. My intention is that the talks build upon each other. I hope to see you there!
