

St. Vincent de Paul Society 2022 Parish Update Fellow St. Dominic's Parishioners;

I am privileged to serve as the President of the St. Dominic's Conference, your Conference, of the SVDP Society. I lead a small but talented group of St. Dominic's Parishioners in service to the poor. We want to thank you sincerely for your prayers, and your continuing generous financial donations, that allow us to represent <u>you</u> as we serve the poor and needy in our town.

THANK YOU! You made a difference in the lives of our neighbors. I also want to assure you that we take very seriously the responsibility to steward the donations that you have entrusted to us, to ensure that these funds are used wisely to make a significant positive impact in the lives of our neighbors. We continue to receive strong support from Fr. Carl and all the Dominicans, as well as from the Parish Staff and the School. We greatly appreciate all their help!

What are we able to accomplish with this support? Here are a few examples to illustrate how we are helping our neighbors:

Over the past year, we made 400 Food deliveries serving 1200 family members.

We delivered 140 Thanksgiving Dinner Boxes and 140 Christmas Dinner gifts to our Neighbors. 500 less-fortunate Children or Seniors received Christmas gifts, including at 7 local Senior Residential homes.

These Holiday programs are ongoing now. We expect to serve a similar number of people again this year. Many of you may think of SVDP's work of providing food, and gifts at Christmas time, as our main mission. But we have grown and are now doing much more.

Our mission includes preventing Homelessness of families that are struggling in Benicia. And to help these families at risk to achieve a sustainable living situation. We start by making a Home Visit with them, to listen and learn of their concerns, challenges, obstacles, and needs.

Over the past year, we made 71 Home Visits with families. We made 33 Housing and rent assistance payments on behalf of families, totaling \$29,200.

107 Utility payments on behalf of families, totaling \$50,475.

Outcomes of these Home Visits include:

- An opportunity for spiritual support when neighbors want it
- Providing Hope and minimizing loneliness
- ◆ Targeted financial assistance to resolve an exceptional debt
- Avoiding water shut offs or evictions
- Partnering with other agencies for longer term support
- Mentoring neighbors with problem-solving ideas and how and where they can get support to improve their situation
- Sharing examples of how to build and follow a budget
- Encouraging them to seek employment, or to improve their employment
- Empowering Neighbors to take the initiative to set a path to help themselves.

We provide A Hand Up, not a handout. In some cases, we are Removing obstacles that allow a Return to employment; or that help them start a new Career that provides a Living Wage for their family.

Many are not aware that Nationally, SVDP has a long history of responding to the aftermath of Disasters. A new initiative for our Conference is to improve our town's disaster preparedness by storing emergency shelter supplies for use by those who cannot prepare on their own - such as seniors and the poor. We are currently building a small storage shed for emergency shelter supplies on the Church lot across the street.


