Pastor's Corner

For my post-Easter getaway the week before last, I hung out with one of my "longest serving" friends, and indeed my first best friend: a guy I've known since Kindergarten. We went to different schools after 4th grade. We kept in occasional touch over the years, so I got to hear when he married, career changes, when his kids were born, and other such milestones. He reminded me that I was present for his now-twentyone-year-old son's first haircut. (That struck a chord: my father kept a picture of that traumatic event from my life on his desk his entire working career; fortunately, it disappeared after he retired. In those days, I was a toe-head blonde, and in the picture, my face was beet-red, and I was clearly screaming my lungs out.) Ironically, as I was leaving from my last haircut, a mom and dad were just bringing in their little one for that big event.

Both of my friend's children are now in college, and he and his wife are adjusting to being empty nesters. Fortunately for me, he decided that, among other things, he wanted to be back in regular contact with me and this trip together was the first of hopefully many. It was also a treat to see his mom and his wife. Sadly, his mom is at the beginning stages of dementia, so she forgot the times over the decades she and I had seen each other and was "stuck" in remembering me when I was in Kindergarten. I must admit though, it was pretty cute and heart-warming to see her face light up, over and over again, as she relived those memories at dinner.

My friend and I were also able to connect with another Kindergarten classmate that I hadn't seen since we were about 12, and my friend hadn't seen since they graduated high school. His communication with us was terse and infrequent. Even until the day we agreed to meet, we weren't sure he was actually going to show up. But happily, he did. Those few hours were a highlight for both of us.

As I approach my 25th anniversary at the end of next month, I am having more and more reminisces about so many people that I have encountered as a priest and as a Dominican. And at the same time, reconnecting with my oldest best friend and this childhood acquaintance, the memory net is bringing up all sorts of folks prior to my Dominican life that I haven't thought about in a very long time. At the same time, I am in the home stretch in my time with you, which is bittersweet: sad to say "goodbye for now" to you and getting excited to see what my next assignment brings.

All of this is reminding me to be grateful, truly and deeply grateful, for all the people in my life, past and present.
