Pastor's Corner

A HAPPY AND BLESSED MOTHER'S DAY TO ALL OUR WONDERFUL MOMS!! You (all) rock!

I am happy to announce that we will have a new friar-in-residence beginning June 10. His name is Fr. Joseph Sergott, O.P. He previously served as Socius & Vicar Provincial, essentially the Provincial's right-hand man, for two previous Provincials. Fr. Joseph currently serves in our Provincial administration as Syndic or Treasurer of the Province. Like me, Fr. Joseph was asked to take on this role by our Chapter back in January of this year. Unlike me, Fr. Joseph's position began immediately upon his appointment. He will be coming from our community in Las Vegas. Stay tuned: he will introduce himself via the bulletin, much like Fr. Andy did last month, in the next few weeks.

Br. Kevin Peter will be leaving us soon. As of writing this, we don't know exactly when his last day will be. If previous years are any indication, it will be sometime before May 26. (May 26 is Br. Patrick Rooney's ordination to the priesthood. Soon-to-be-Father Patrick will offer two Masses of Thanksgiving, 9:00 and 11:00 a.m., on Sunday, June 4 here in Benicia.) Stay tuned for more details about his farewell. And, as of writing this, we don't know if we will be getting a Residency Brother for the next academic year. (The priests' assignments are not yet completed; usually, the assignments for the brothers going on Residency are not announced until they are.)

I had planned to be away for about three weeks at the beginning of June, to travel with my Dominican classmates for our jubilee. Unfortunately, the priest I had engaged to come and help while I was away can no longer come due to health issues. I am immensely grateful to Fr. Joseph for helping Fr. Gregory with some of the daily Masses, so that I will be able to get away for about 10 days. The plan is for my last weekend here in Benicia to be June 25. I do not know yet when I will be able to begin moving to St. Albert's, but I expect that I will be in and out from the time I get back from my trip on June 19 and the official beginning of my new ministry on July 1.

Speaking of which, by the time you read this, I will have had a meeting with our Provincial, Fr. Christopher, and others to nail down some details of what I will be doing. As I have said to those of you who have asked me: at this point, I don't even have a job title yet!

So, yes, there are still a lot of things up in the air. Please pray for all involved and be patient. As I reminded those attending my book study: just remember, God wins!

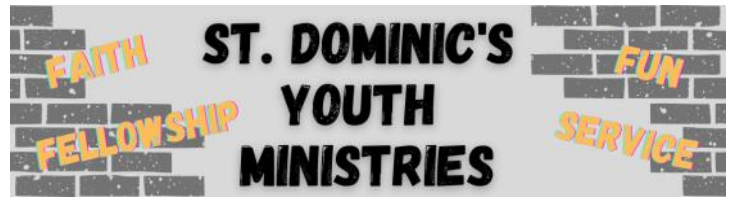
