Pastor's Corner

Pentecost, this, and that

I am happy to let you know that we will be having a student brother with us for June and July; he will be doing online language study. His name is Br. John Paul Puschautz, O.P. He will arrive early this week. While his time with us will be mostly focused on studies, you will be seeing him around at Mass and other events. As of writing this Corner, he and I haven't spoken about any ministries he might be interested in doing while he's here. Also, as of writing this Corner, the Provincial has not announced any more assignments for next year, so the Student Master has not said anything about next year's Residency Brothers' assignments. Speaking of Residency Brothers, Br. Kevin Peter got safely back to St. Albert's last week.

"To stay together was the condition laid down by Jesus in order to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit; the premise of their harmony was prolonged prayer. In this way, we are offered a formidable lesson for every Christian community. Some think at times that missionary effectiveness depends primarily on careful programming and its subsequent intelligent application through a concrete commitment. The Lord certainly does ask for our collaboration, but before any other response his initiative is necessary: his Spirit is the true protagonist of the Church. The roots of our being and of our action are in the wise and provident silence of God... The Church has been catholic and missionary from her birth. The universality of salvation is meaningfully manifested with the list of the numerous ethnic groups to which those who heard the Apostles' first proclamation belonged (cf. Acts 2: 9-11). The People of God, which had found its first configuration in Sinai, extends today to the point of surmounting every barrier of race, culture, space and time. As opposed to what occurred with the tower of Babel (cf. Gn 11: 1-9), when people wanted to build a way to heaven with their hands and ended up by destroying their very capacity of mutual understanding, in Pentecost the Spirit, with the gift of tongues, demonstrates that his presence unites and transforms *confusion* into *communion*. Human pride and egoism always create divisions, build walls of indifference, hate and violence. The Holy Spirit, on the other hand, makes hearts capable of understanding the languages of all, as he re-establishes the bridge of authentic communion between earth and heaven. The Holy Spirit is Love." Pope Benedict XVI, June 4, 2006

It is a blessing for me to celebrate my 25th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood with you, especially since we could not celebrate my (and Fr. Jerome's) 50th birthday back in 2020. My ordination was the Friday before Pentecost and my First Mass was the Vigil of Pentecost, so celebrating my silver jubilee on Pentecost is a beautiful symmetry! Organ Prelude: Priere apres la communion ("Prayer after the Communion") by Olivier Messiaen.

This piece by the great French organist-composer is part of the cycle *Le livre du Saint-Sacrement*. Messiaen had been the organist at the [Église de la Sainte-Trinité, Paris](#) since 1931, and by his own account he brought to summation his years of experience improvising music for the liturgy in the composition of the *Livre*. As a modern composer, Messiaen uses complex harmonies to express deep meditation on the mystery of sacraments.

Organ Postlude: The Majesty and Power of His Name by Lyndell Leatherman

In this arrangement, Leatherman combines 2 beloved tunes for the text All Hail the Power of Jesus Name: *Diadem*, written by 19-year old Englishman James Ellor, and *Coronation*, composed by Oliver Holden.

Choral anthem (post-Communion meditation): Now Sing before the Lord by Mozart, arr. Douglas Wagner

In his arraignment of a canon by Mozart, Douglas Wagner uses the text that talks about all nature glorifying God for His blessings
