

## **Pastor's Corner**

Mary, the Jewish Mother

So often in western art, the mother of Jesus is portrayed as a soft, delicate and demure young woman, even a girl. These visuals help us to remember Mary's innocence and purity. She is that beyond doubt; it was from her flesh that the God the Word human and "pitched his tent among us." I think we often forget that Mary of Nazareth was a Jewish mother. Jewish mothers are known for their tenacious and out-spoken pride in their children, not to mention tough love.

But one of my favorite titles for Mary comes from the Eastern churches: Champion-leader. Mary is the highest and most exalted member of the Church. She stands in glory, but labors still to ensure all of us, her adopted children (cf. John 19:26-27), Jesus' sisters and brothers by Baptism, share what he won: salvation and glory. The image of "champion-leader" conjures not a shy, timid girl, but someone more like a St. Joan of Arc: in full armor and sword, ready to take on anyone and anything that threatens her children. She is also called the Scourge of Demons, showing us that she takes her role as our spiritual mother quite seriously!

It is not surprising that the Scriptures use maternal love as an analogate for God's love: "As a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you;" (Is. 66:13)," "Can a mother forget her infant, be without tenderness for the child of her womb? Even should she forget, I will never forget you," (Is. 49:15).

Yet it is just that, an analogy: God's love is not just greater in magnitude than ours, but in kind. Because we are finite, imperfect creatures, so our love is also finite and imperfect. Unlike our love, God's love cannot be distorted or perverted. We honor Mary as our Blessed Mother because she shows us what perfect human love looks like. She is a model for all who follow her Son; she would never have said to Jesus, nor does she say to us: Do as I say, not as I do! (Remember your parents using that as a cop out? Or maybe even you have used it yourself. For me, yes, and yes!)

Like any good parent, Mary calls us to imitate her, not by a mere rote repeating of her deeds or WWMD, but rather to have our deeds rooted in communion with Jesus and in tune with the heart and mind of God. It is a challenge because, unlike her, we are not free from sin. (And our ability to delude ourselves or to settle for moral mediocrity is great.) Like any good mother, Mary calls and challenges us to be better than we are right now. Being good is not good enough: we are made to be great. And she, our champion-leader is right, in front, leading the charge!
