

Pastor's Corner

Signing off

Dear Parishioners of St. Dominic's.

This will be my last *Pastor's Corner*. I will be in and out this week, moving my things to St. Albert's, but you will see me for sure at one of the morning Masses. Fr. Andy will be arriving on Friday, June 30, and I will be leaving that same day for St. Albert's. I am still in awe of the beautiful celebration of my silver jubilee last month. Thank you!

Our time together has been very blessed for me; I am grateful to the Good Lord and to you for those many, many blessings. Together, we got through a world-wide pandemic and its long-ranging ramifications. The parish and school not only survived but are, I believe, ready for a "growth spurt;" the school has already begun to experience it: it will be closer to maximum capacity next school year than any time in recent memory. Our activities and ministries are in full swing. Although our collections have not quite returned to prepandemic levels, we have adequate savings to cover this short-term shortfall. Thanks to several generous bequests in the last four years, we also have enough savings to begin working on capital projects like refurbishing the parish hall (currently in the planning stages, but hopefully completed this summer), sealing the upper windows of the church, repairing and repainting the church's exterior, and resurfacing the parking lots. These projects are also, in one way or another, underway, but further off in completion.

Using part of a bequest from the estate of Jeri Lange, I commissioned a piece of art that you will soon see in the sanctuary, immediately behind the tabernacle. The blue wallpaper, which is in bad shape, will be replaced by a mural of seven angels in the style of Fra Angelico. (The banners hung in the sanctuary throughout the year are all by Fra Angelico.) I commissioned local artist and DSPT student Justyn Zolli for this work. Justyn painted (and repaired) the statue of Our Lady in the Garden of Hope. All the Benicia friars were very excited when I shared Justyn's mockup with them. It should be installed very soon.

I am very much looking forward to seeing what you and Fr. Andy will accomplish together in the upcoming years. I will support Fr. Andy however I can, and I will come up for a visit now and then. (He has already invited me to his installation in September.) You (and he) will be in my prayers these next few months especially.

Again, thank you. May God continue to bless you!







<u>Music Notes</u> Sunday, June 25, 2023

Organ Prelude (7:30 and 11:00 a.m.)
Meditation (Communion) by the French composer and organist
Jean Langlais is based on a chant Ubi Caritas, and is part of the
cycle of liturgical organ pieces "Suite Medievale". Even though
Langlais was blind, he was appointed organist at St. Clotilde
Basilica in Paris, following in the footsteps of the great Cesar

Franck.

Communion meditation (7:30 a.m.) Pie Jesu from Requiem by Gabriel Faure:

The Pie Jesu is the centerpiece of Fauré's Requiem, which he completed in 1890, and which is often considered his greatest composition. It is undoubtedly imbued with the deepest sentiments of devotion. A requiem, as such a mass for the dead, is a distinct musical genre and a Christian liturgical art form.

Organ Postlude: (7:30 and 11:00 a.m.)
"The Joys awaiting" by Lyndell Leatherman
This arrangement by Leatherman combines two ancient hymns which anticipate the eternals rewards of heaven: "Jerusalem, my happy home" "Land of Rest", anonymous early American melody.



Theology through Beauty: The *Summa* in Paint of Blessed Fra Angelico, O.P. Series with Br. John Paul

We will contemplate the core mysteries of the Christian Faith through the paintings of Bl. Fra Angelico, OP, the patron saint of artists. Pope St John Paul II describes this 15th-century Dominican best. "Spiritual son of Saint Dominic, he expressed his "summa" of the divine mysteries with his brush, just as Thomas Aquinas enunciated it with theological language." This will not be abstract theology but a practical school of prayer and meditation on Scripture with the help of this great artist who contemplated the Sacred humanity of Jesus Christ and shared the fruits of his contemplation. The beauty of his art can practically heal the wounded imagination and deepen our relationship with Jesus and Mary.
