I understand why the Provincial needed his expertise elsewhere, but I am sad that the friars' and parish communities will not be enjoying Fr. Joseph's experience, good humor and prayer.

Summer Student Brother: Br. John Paul Puschautz, O.P. (pronounced "push-OUTS") arrived safely last week. He will begin his coursework on Monday. He is also hoping to give some presentations while he's here, so be on the lookout for those.

2023-2024 Residency Brother: I am happy to let you know that next year's residency assignments were announced last week. Br. Anselm Dominic LeFave, OP will be joining you in the fall. Organ Prelude: Improvisation from Suite Medievale by Jean Langlais.

Jean Langlais (15 February 1907 – 8 May 1991) was a French [composer](#) of [modern classical music](#), [organist](#), and [improviser](#). It was as an organist that Langlais made his name, following in the footsteps of [César Franck](#) and Charles Tournemire as *organiste titulaire* at the [Basilica of Sainte-Clotilde](#) in Paris in 1945, a post in which he remained until 1988.

"Suite Medievale" is one of his most popular organ works, merging Gregorian chant with the spirit of French Gothic cathedrals built in medieval times.

Organ Postlude: Joyful Interlude in A by Colin Mawby

Colin Mawby (9 May 1936 – 24 November 2019) was an English organist, [choral](#) conductor and composer. From 1961 he was Master of Music at [Westminster Cathedral](#), then from 1981 he was the choral director at [Radio Telefís Éireann](#). He composed masses dedicated to specific choirs, including in Germany. He was awarded Knighthood of the [Order of St. Gregory](#) in 2006.

Theology through Beauty: The *Summa* in Paint of Blessed Fra Angelico, O.P. Series with Br. John Paul

We will contemplate the core mysteries of the Christian Faith through the paintings of Bl. Fra Angelico, OP, the patron saint of artists. Pope St John Paul II describes this 15th-century Dominican best. "Spiritual son of Saint Dominic, he expressed his "summa" of the divine mysteries with his brush, just as Thomas Aquinas enunciated it with theological language." This will not be abstract theology but a practical school of prayer and meditation on Scripture with the help of this great artist who contemplated the Sacred humanity of Jesus Christ and shared the fruits of his contemplation. The beauty of his art can practically heal the wounded imagination and deepen our relationship with Jesus and Mary.

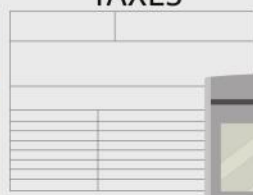
