Pastor's Corner



Well, after a few weeks here in Benicia, it sure is clear to me how much potential there is to evangelize this town. A few Thursday evenings back, Br. John Paul, a small group of parishioners, and some young adult musicians set up a ministry site just

outside the Benicia Farmers Market on 1st Street. As the musicians played praise and worship music, Br. John Paul and the other parishioners greeted people, offered to pray for them, and passed out

cards advertising the parish. Some of the evangelizers said they felt a little awkward when they started, but quickly they were surprised by how many strangers



were willing to take the parish cards. Some pedestrians walked right up to Br. John Paul and the others and asked for prayers. Also, a group of our parishioners stopped by and began singing on the street with the musicians.



Once I finished hearing confessions at the church, I raced down to 1st Street to join our crew near the end of the event. After we packed up the music equipment and those who

needed to get home departed, I treated the rest of our group to beverages at Lucca's. The restaurant's outdoor seating area was packed with folks enjoying each other's company and a lively band covering Bob Dylan songs. It was delightful. Once we got our drinks, we snagged a sidewalk table and swapped stories about encounters we had had with curious patrons of the outdoor marketplace. As we sat enjoying the evening breeze, several customers in Lucca's waved at us cheerfully, some holding out the St. Dominic's cards they had accepted from us. You would not believe how many kind people stopped by our table to introduce themselves and ask questions. People who long for God are surely walking throughout Benicia on a daily basis. We just have to show up and be the means by which Our Lord can connect to the souls who have either been away from Jesus or have yet to encounter Him!





Confirmation



Music Notes - July 23, 2023

Organ music for 7:30 a.m. Mass: Organ prelude: Andantino by Edwin H. Lemare

Edwin Henry Lemare (1865 –1934) was an English <u>organist</u> and <u>composer</u> who lived the latter part of his life in the United States. He was one of the most highly regarded organists of his generation, as well as the greatest performer. One of his major accomplishments was performing at the Panama-Pacific International Exposition in San Francisco in 1915, and then remaining in San Francisco for several years as a city organist.

Organ Postlude: The Rejoicing from Firework music by Handel

George Frideric Handel composed "The Music for the Royal Fireworks" in 1749 under contract of George II of Great Britain for the fireworks in London's Green Park. The music celebrates the signing of the Treaty of Aix-la-Chapelle (Aachen) in 1748. The work was very popular when first performed and following Handel's death, as well as to this day.

7:30 a.m. Communion meditation: Jesus Lover of my soul, arr. by Joseph Martin

This gentle and tender arrangement of Charles Wesley's enduring hymn celebrates the 300th anniversary of his birth. Beautifully and thoughtfully set, it reminds us to seek a closer relationship with Jesus.
