Pastor's Corner



As Catholics, we are taught to learn about the lives of the canonized saints in order to get inspiration for being great saints ourselves. Reading about the saints with the wrong mindset, however, can leave us discouraged, rather than inspired. For example, the

stories of the numerous martyr saints could make us think, "My gosh, I could never die for my faith. How am I supposed to relate to Christians who lived such radically heroic virtue?" While we are not all called to walk the paths of those famous Christians, there is a quality of soul they all had that we all surely can cultivate within ourselves. That necessary quality of soul is indicated by a passage in this Sunday's Gospel from Matthew. In that Gospel, Jesus likens the Kingdom of God to a "pearl of great price" for which a merchant and sold all he owned so that he could have that one most magnificent pearl. The great saints were able to accomplish spectacular feats for God because they viewed the Kingdom of God as such a pearl. No doubt for many of those saints, the more they viewed the Kingdom in this way, the more they found themselves willing to do difficult things for God that they would not have been willing to do in days prior.

For a comparison to everyday life, consider a few more worldly examples. Did you ever find yourself a likely prospect for a great promotion at work for which you had not previously considered yourself worthy? Did the consequent chase for that promotion unlock all kinds of ability and drive you never realized you possessed all along? Or did you ever get a huge crush on someone? Once it happened, were you suddenly willing to do impressive things and generally be a dramatically better version of yourself in order to bond with that person and win his or her affections?

Of course, the path to sainthood involves seeing God as something much greater than a hot promotion or a dream-date. It's about loving God as the one pearl above all others. We can cultivate this love of him by reflecting routinely on what a precious gift his Kingdom is and how impoverished we would be without it. Expanding our love for God involves making time for him everyday and orienting all aspects of our lives toward growth in that loving union. The more we do this, the more the stories of the saints will inspire us rather than deflate us. Who knows what saintly potential God is waiting to unlock in you that will inspire future generations of Christians!

Organ music for 7:30 and 11 a.m. masses Prelude: Arioso by J.S.Bach, arr. by Frank Asper

J.S.Bach, considered to be one of the greatest composers of all time, was a devout Christian who dedicated all of his music, particularly cantatas, to Lord Jesus Christ. This piece is an arrangement of a movement from cantata 156, originally written for a small orchestra

Organ Postlude: Overture from Firework music by Handel

George Frideric Handel composed "The Music for the Royal Fireworks" in 1749 under contract of George II of Great Britain for the fireworks in London's Green Park. The music celebrates the signing of the Treaty of Aix-la-Chapelle (Aachen) in 1748. The work was very popular when first performed and following Handel's death, as well as to this day.
