



Pastor's Corner

Greetings, parishioners of Saint Dominic's! I hope you all had a restful and jubilant Fourth of July holiday. Mine began with the Torchlight Parade on 1st Street. The parade was delightful because of all the wonderful town participants, but especially because Fr. Gregory, Br. John Paul, and I ran into several of you on the sidewalks. We even saw some of you on parade floats! The following morning, I finally got the chance to go jogging around town. As I trotted past the marina, the beautiful historic churches, Benicia Capitol Historic State Park, and peeked into bakeries and ice cream shops, I felt like I was in a Hallmark movie. Sitting on a bench overlooking the water. reflected on the wonderful weekend I had just shared with everybody in the parish and thought, "My gosh, I've only been here a few days, and I already feel like I don't ever want to leave!" In addition to being pastor of our spectacular parish and living in this movie setting of a town, my immediate family, with whom I am very close, all live within easy driving distance. My parents reside in Lincoln, while one sister lives with her family in Roseville and the other lives even closer with her husband and kids in Vacaville. Surely, at times, this pastoral assignment will involve frustrations and challenges to overcome, but still, I keep pinching myself. If we do that, we can end up looking back on our lives later and realize we missed out on truly enjoying many of those blessings while God was giving them to us.

Very often, many of us stray from God during easy times, only to return to him when problems arise. By contrast, if we stay close to God and work at growing in our relationship with him throughout the fun times, we will have a much stronger foundation spiritually for navigating new difficulties. Additionally, that stronger spiritual foundation can give us vision to recognize the blessings God is bestowing on us even during times of hardship. When we can accomplish that, with the help of God's grace, of course, it will be a sign that he is helping us to grow in spiritual maturity. Growth in spiritual maturity, after all, is essential to the purpose for which we remain in this world. My prayer for all of us as a parish, is that we will continue supporting each other in growth to the full perfection of that spiritual maturity. It is the only true path to the happiness for which God created us.

Theology through Beauty: The *Summa* in Paint of Blessed Fra Angelico, O.P. Series with Br. John Paul
