## Pastor's Corner



This past week, the Western Dominican Province had a funeral for Fr. Paschal Salisbury, a priest of our province for 56 years. I was blessed to live for half a year with him at St. Dominic's Parish in San Francisco when I was a novice during the fall and spring of 2011-2012. As we lay

him to rest at St. Dominic's Cemetery here in Benicia, I thought about the threefold reason we as Catholics have funerals. The first reason is to commend our departed brothers and sisters to God. By all accounts, Father Paschal died a deeply faithful man, and so we have reason to be confident that he is in the loving care of our Lord right now.

The second reason we have funerals is to pray for our departed loved ones' souls. As Catholics, we believe that when many of us die, we still need to be purified of some of our sinfulness in Purgatory, the purification as though by fire Saint Paul describes in 1 Corinthians 3:11-15. Our prayers for the dead can help speed things along for the souls undergoing this purification. In light of this, it is a good idea to incorporate prayers for our deceased family members and friends into our everyday lives. For example, we Dominicans pray every evening before dinner for the brothers of our province who have passed away. While we certainly found Fr. Paschal to be a very holy Dominican, we want to make sure that if his soul could use prayers to be completely cleansed, we are offering those prayers.

Thirdly, a funeral is an occasion for each of us to examine how we are doing in our own walk with the Lord. Next time you are at a funeral, when you see the coffin or urn, remind yourself that one day your own remains will be in that place. Bringing that truth back before our minds can stimulate our minds and hearts to focus anew on God and what kind of priority we give him. It is very easy to allow worldly concerns to dominate our minds and hearts and treat our spiritual lives as something we will tend to later when we are very old. Saint Paul cautions against this sort of spiritual sleepiness when he warns us in 1 Thessalonians 5:2 that the Lord could come for us at any time like a thief in the night. Because of this, it was common for many of the early spiritual masters to keep skulls on their desks to remind them death could come at any time, which helped them keep their priorities rightly ordered.

Attending a funeral can provide that reminder as well. Funerals are about more than offering emotional closure to the people the deceased have left behind in this life. Far more so, they are meant to help us on our way to everlasting happiness with each other and Our Lord in Heaven.

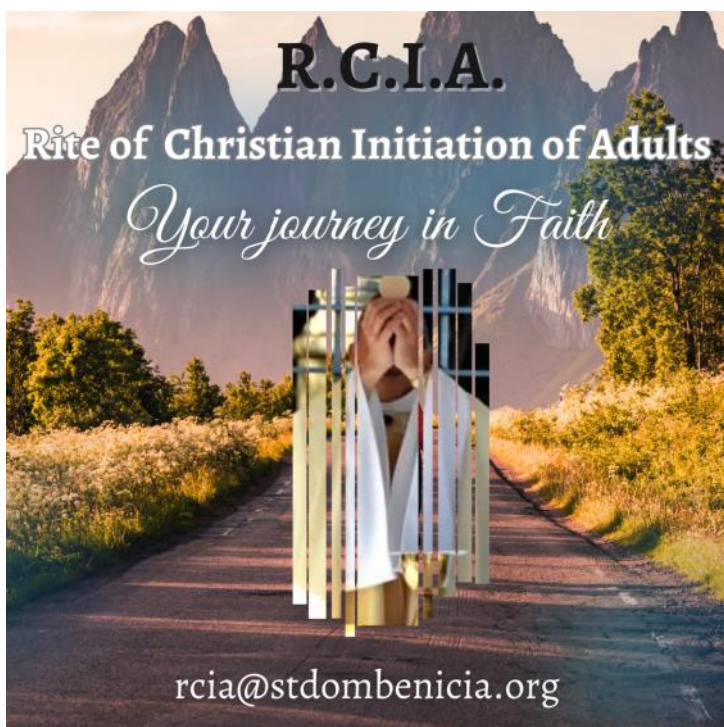

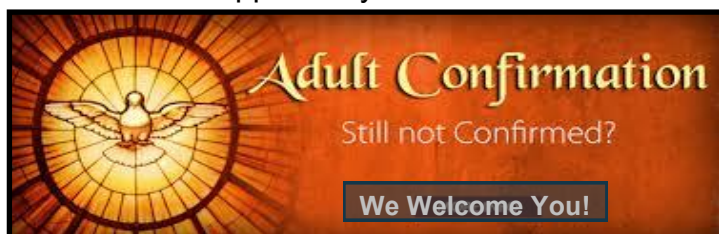

# becoming a catechist

Our Rel Ed Program serves grade levels Kinder through 7<sup>th</sup> and will have its first class in early October. Each year, Bishop Soto extends an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation to practicing adult Catholics of the Diocese of Sacramento who are baptized, have received First Communion, and have received religious instruction since their First Communion, but for various reasons were never received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

The next celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation is scheduled for Saturday, November 4, 2023, St. Mary's Church, 350 Stinson Ave., Vacaville, 5:00 p.m. Candidates will be prepared at the parish level by completing 8 sessions held over a series of consecutive Sundays from September 10, 2023 through October 29, 2023, 2:00-3:30 p.m., St. Dominic's Ministry Center, Siena Rm.

Sacrament preparation will include prayer, scripture and a review of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. To participate the candidate must be a baptized Catholic, who has received catechetical instruction at least up to receiving the Eucharist (First Communion), be either unmarried or in a marriage recognized as valid by the Catholic Church, and have a recent copy of their Baptismal Certificate certified within the past 6 months. Confirmation candidates must select a Sponsor who must be Catholic, received the Sacrament of Confirmation, is a practicing Catholic, and is at least 16 years of age.

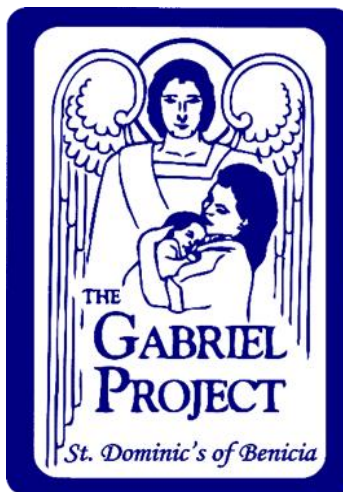

## Music Notes - August 27, 2023

Organ Music for the 7:30 & 11 a.m.

Prelude: Félix-Alexandre Guilmant (1837 – 1911) was a French organist and composer. He was the organist of La Trinité from 1871 until 1901. A noted pedagogue, performer, and improviser, Guilmant helped found the Schola Cantorum de Paris. He was appointed as Professor of Organ at the Paris Conservatoire in 1896. In 1871 he was appointed to play the organ regularly at la Trinité church in Paris, and this position, *organiste titulaire*, was one he held for 30 years.

His Invocation invites us to a quiet prayer before the start of the Mass.

Postlude:

The Rejoicing from the Firework music by Handel

George Frideric Handel composed "The Music for the Royal Fireworks" in 1749 under contract of George II of Great Britain. The work was very popular when first performed and following Handel's death, as well as to this day.
