


Altar Flowers for the **Soul of Eugenio Caldo Mass Intentions**

Pastor's Corner



About four weeks ago, I took up the practice of attending our school's Saturday football games when my schedule would permit it. I am trying to attend some of

the girls' volleyball games, too, but those are more difficult for me to catch because they happen on Sundays. I pray with the athletes and bless them before their games, and they have been teaching me some of the different cheers and letting me lead those, which has been a blast. The whole thing is turning out to be one of my favorite things to do as pastor.

The priestly vocation I accepted meant I would never have any biological children of my own, but the good news is I still get to do the 'sports dad' thing as a spiritual father. Standing on the football sideline with the cheering families, yards of green grass all around us, and the blue California sky overhead, makes for a truly wonderful Saturday morning. Some of the parents seem to feel they are being run ragged at times, getting all of their kids to their different games. Their fatigue is totally understandable. I do hope, however, for the most part they savor these Saturdays, because later in life they will likely look back on these times with longing.

Part of what is so much fun about watching the kids enjoy their sports is that, as adults, we get to share in the fun vicariously, sort of the way Christmas regains its magic when seen through the eyes of the children who enter our lives. I love talking football with the boys, especially because most of them are Niners fans like me. For all of our kids, I wish for them to know the exhilaration and joy of winning, but also to develop the self-mastery of being able to face loss with grace. When praying with the kids, I always encourage them to be grateful – win or lose – for the gift of that day and to enjoy it, knowing they are all winners, sharing in Christ's victory over sin and death through his Passion, death, and Resurrection. Our share in his winning record is what matters most, which we need to remind ourselves every day, because life goes by so fast. Since having become pastor, at times it seems like I blink and another Sunday is gone. Let us all commit to appreciating this journey's little blessings as we follow Christ home to the Father.






