# Brother's Column

## The School of Charity

It is a frustrating truth about God's providence in human life that the movements of the Spirit are often seen with clarity only in hindsight. Through the acceptance of a call to a definite state of life in the Church, however, whether that be marriage, religious life, or priesthood, God beautifully provides us with a way of life to which we can commit ourselves and know that we are on a path that leads to love and to God – even as many uncertainties remain.

In my own time as a Dominican friar, I have already seen how this form of life is a school of charity, and a powerful manifestation of the Gospel's light in this world. I try to reflect often on my life in the Order, and how much I have changed from my entrance as a postulant to my life now as a residency brother in simple vows. This life has pressed me close to the Heart of Christ, and no one can be immersed in the blazing charity of His Heart without being transformed. I haven't always been able to see it at the time, but looking back, I can see that I have been profoundly changed for the better.

When a young man applies to enter our Province, he is required to write a spiritual autobiography, in which he reflects on the activity of God in his life so far, and how he has been drawn toward and prepared for religious life. Among other things, the candidate is asked what he expects his greatest strengths in community life will be. In response, I wrote about how I considered myself to be kind, gracious, and edifying in discussions with people different from myself. When I wrote that, I really believed that to be true! However, when I was accepted into the Order and began the novitiate, I discovered that I was suddenly living very intimately with men who were more different from me culturally, politically, and temperamentally than any with whom I had ever been so close. I am ashamed to say that I did not initially react very well to my new brothers – I was reactive, defensive, and emotional. But by God's grace, which suffuses religious life, I was able to recognize that these other men were as in love with Jesus Christ as I was, or more so. We were fundamentally united in our faith, and our deep desire to love God and to serve Him and His People.

I am so happy and grateful to say that those fellow novices of mine, with whom I disagreed so much at first, have become true friends and brothers to me, united in our common vocation as followers of Christ and sons of St. Dominic. Through them, Jesus opened my heart and expanded my capacity for love. These are the kinds of lessons which Dominican life

has taught me, and in our different ways, every Dominican friar has been transformed by the love available to us in this life. I love being a Friar Preacher, and I am so grateful to God for granting me the grace to perceive and accept His call, and I am no less grateful to all those whose charitable alms make this life of love and service possible.

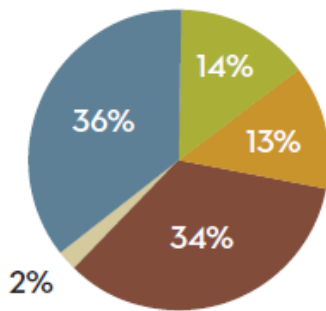

## MUSIC NOTES : OCTOBER 8, 2023

Organ Prelude: Ave Maria, attributed to Giulio Caccini  
This setting of Ave Maria became one of the most popular settings of the Latin text. Some doubt that it was composed by Giulio Caccini. Stil, **Caccini** ( 1551 – 1618) was an Italian composer, teacher, singer, instrumentalist and writer of the late Renaissance and early Baroque eras. He was one of the founders of the genre of opera, and one of the most influential creators of the new Baroque style.

Organ Postlude: Trumpet Air by Henry Purcell

**Henry Purcell** ( 1659 - 1695) was an English composer of Baroque music.

Purcell's musical style was uniquely English, although it incorporated Italian and French elements. Generally considered among the greatest English opera composers, one of his most important works is Te Deum, performed every year at St. Paul's Cathedral in London.

Choral anthem (post-Communion meditation): Now Sing before the Lord by Mozart, arr. Douglas Wagner  
In his arraignment of a canon by Mozart, Douglas Wagner uses the text that talks about all nature glorifying God for His blessings. It seems to echo the Gospel text "My soul does magnify the Lord...."
