

Pastor's Corner



One of the fun things about being at a parish run by a religious order, like Saint Dominic's, is that you get to share in the special memorials and feast days of that religious order. Last Tuesday was one such occasion - the Feast of All Saints of the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans). The feast is basically a

Dominican version of All Saints Day. On the Feast of All the Saints of the Order of Preachers, rather than focusing on canonized saints, we celebrate all of the Dominicans in Heaven. It is an important thing to celebrate, given that obtaining perfect union with Our Lord through a life of prayer, contemplation, and preaching all rooted in the pursuit of perfect charity is the primary aim of any Dominican's life. While serving that aim looks different for Dominican friars, sisters, and laity, if the Dominican is in Heaven, it means that goal has been actualized for him or her. And when you read about the various Dominican saints, it becomes clear the order has quite a broad umbrella for very different kinds of holy people.

While they may differ in numerous ways, one does pick up on some patterns in regard to how they pursued sanctity. One is that they are always individuals who made their prayer life an essential priority for daily living. No doubt this enabled them to retain their focus on serving Our Lord in the face of so many of the worldly distractions the Devil tries to fling at all of us. I cannot tell you how many confessions I hear from people who attribute dips in their moral lives to having let their prayer life go slack. Also, being assiduous in their study of sacred doctrine tends to be key to the spiritual growth of Dominican saints. Sacred study is meant to lift the spiritual ignorance from our minds in a way that quickens us on our path to He who is truth Himself. Additionally, the Dominican saints who are especially noteworthy tend to be good about practicing penance. Offering up sacrifices to the Lord that discipline our passions is a very helpful way of working with the Spirit as it purifies and gradually rightly directs our will and general capacity to love more and more toward love of God and love of neighbor for love of God. There are so many lessons the Dominican saints can teach us about the path to Heaven, but if we give special attention to those three aforementioned spiritual practices, we are bound to become more like them as they cheer for our progress toward joining them at the Heavenly wedding banquet!

Organ Music for 7:30 and 11:00 a.m. Masses
Prelude: Invocation by Guilmant
Félix-Alexandre Guilmant (1837 – 1911) was a
French organist and composer. He was the organist of La Trinité from 1871 until 1901. A noted pedagogue, performer, and improviser, Guilmant helped found the Schola Cantorum de Paris. He was appointed as Professor of Organ at the Paris Conservatoire in 1896.In 1871 he was appointed to play the organ regularly at la Trinité church in Paris, and this position, organiste titulaire, was one he held for 30 years. His Invocation invites us to a quiet prayer before the start of the Mass. Postlude: The Rejoicing from the Firework music by Handel
George Frideric Handel composed "The Music for the Royal Fireworks" in 1749 under contract of George II of Great Britain. The work was very popular when first performed and following Handel's death, as well as to this day.

Choral meditation for Communion: Cantate
Dominum by Giuseppe Pitoni
One of the singular most important musicians of the late Italian Baroque, Giuseppe Ottavio Pitoni (1657-1743) was an organist, conductor (maestro di cappella), theorist, and composer of hundreds of Masses, motets, and choral settings of the office. He was affiliated with several churches in Rome, including the Basilica of San Marco (for some 66 years), St. John Lateran, and the Cappella Giulia at St. Peter's Basilica. Cantate
Dominum (Sing to the Lord a new song) is one of his most popular sacred works.
