

## **Pastor's Corner**



A good Thanksgiving holiday has some truly wonderful but simple pleasures. Those may look different for different people, but I imagine what most of our ideal Thanksgivings have in common is they invoke within us a feeling of contentedness. This is appropriate, given that the primary aim of the holiday

is meant to be gratitude, and having gratitude makes it easier for us to be content. And having contentedness rooted in gratitude is an essential component of happiness. A lack of gratitude, by comparison, leads to various causes of misery – one of them sometimes being an attitude of entitlement. Not everybody may associate feelings of being entitled with misery, but I do. Having an inordinate sense of deservingness toward our neighbors and especially toward God almost cannot help but ensure we are kept unsatisfied. It is a near sure path to chronic disappointment, insecurity, anxiousness, and resentment of others. Yes, life can be terribly difficult, but facing those difficulties with gratitude for the blessings we do possess is a lot more pleasant than facing hard times without any thankfulness. If we can cultivate gratitude as a habit, it can keep us grounded during both the fun years and the harder ones.

I like to think teaching this sort of gratitude was at the heart of the Thanksgiving "feast" the kids in our parish school had this past week. (Can you believe they get the entire Thanksgiving week off?! We were all thrilled as kids just to get that four-day weekend for the holiday.) Anyway, the kids had their own little Charlie Brown Thanksgiving style feast, but with no turkey, stuffing, and so forth – just simple snacks. I hope it taught the kids how much potential fun there is in whatever God provides them. For most of them, their lives will include some lean times, but the entire journey can be a happy one with gratitude.

When it finishes, you will still have plenty of time for watching the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade, football games, playing catch outside, and all of those other wonderful but simple pleasures of the holiday! 
