## **Pastor's Corner**



If you watch any of the numerous documentaries or the Netflix series about the life of Queen Elizabeth II, you will see a key value her long reign provided England was a sense of consistency during tumultuous cultural change. Over the course of her more than seventy years as queen, the

United Kingdom saw many different leaders of parliament and many cultural fads come and go. The reign of Elizabeth II remained a constant through all of that change, a constant that, partially, was meant to remind the Brits who they were as a people. The Solemnity of Christ the King was instituted in 1925 to remind Christians of Christ's reign as the one true king and the one true constant in the midst of radical governmental change around the world. The feast day came with an encyclical from Pope Pius XI called Quas primas to respond to growing secularism and atheism at the time. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever. Emphasizing the eternal reign of Christ is meant, partially, to remind us who we are as members of his body.

No doubt our individual identities draw from our families and governmental and cultural influences, but our own sense of who we are and what is most important about us should always be rooted in the influence of Christ, our King. The more focused our identities are on Jesus and his holy reign, the less frightened we will be of worldly rejection and persecution. Worldly esteem can be taken away from us by others, but no one can take us from the protection of God's kingdom. As Saint Paul reminds us in Romans 8:38-39, "For I am sure that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

I did anointings for two different people on their death beds this week. The experience is always such a powerful reminder of how ephemeral worldly glories are and how reassuring the constancy of Christ's reign is. Being a Christian can feel profoundly difficult at times, and giving in to prevailing fashions that are at odds with our faith can be tempting. But it is a temptation that does not pay because anything truly at odds with our faith is bankrupt. Let us stay focused on obeying the reign of Christ. His Kingdom will be the only thing standing in the end.




