

Pastor's Corner



Well, after quite a short fourth Sunday of Advent today, Christmas will have arrived, and what a cause for rejoicing! Christ is born! He is great, the Son of the Most High, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. He saves us from our sins, and of his kingdom there will be no end. We glorify God at this news because, as the angels

proclaim to the shepherds, his birth carries with it news of peace to those on whom his favor rests. We call Jesus "Prince of Peace" because he is the only true source of peace that exists. Saint Thomas Aquinas describes peace as tranquility rooted in order. And ultimate, total peace one day will be, for those who persevere in faith, a tranquility rooted in the peace of Christ – a harmony for us with one another and with God established and made everlasting by the Son's Passion, death, and Resurrection. In Saint Paul's Letter to the Philippians. he paints a picture of what this peace should look like when he testifies of Christ that "God greatly exalted him, and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus, every knee should bend, of those in Heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." At that point, whatever within is wrong, out of order, so to speak, will be made right, making us totally free.

As I said last Sunday, our drive to love will find its full outlet in love of God through our share in Christ's loving union with the Father. In God our drive to love cannot help but find its full outlet because he is the fulfillment of all desire. There will certainly be no more sorrow, because he is the one who makes all things new. He will wipe every tear from our eyes, as the Book of Revelation tells us. It promises that through the King born on this day, there will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the former things will have passed away. And we shall reign with him forever. What a cause to rejoice! On top of all of that, this will be my first Christmas with all of you here at St. Dominic's in Benicia! Now, I'm sure you have wonderful plans for this glorious feast, but do yourself a favor, and do not burden yourself so much with obligations during this time that you become eager for the whole thing to pass. Let your heart be lightened by the full significance of what we celebrate. And celebrate it for the full season! December 25th is only its first day! Merry Christmas, everybody!
