Pastor's Corner



This Sunday's celebration of the Feast of the Holy Family is an especially joyful one for us at St. Dominic's, because serving our parish's young families and welcoming new ones to join our regular community here in Benicia is a core goal of our pastoral strategy. The Feast of the Holy Family

honors the earthly family of Jesus as the holiest of families, making them a role model for all families. A key aspect of what made them such a model family was that they kept Jesus Christ at the center of their family. In the case of the Holy Family, of course, this was true physically, as well as spiritually! As Catholics, we see the family as the "Domestic Church," and keeping Christ at the center is essential to raising kids in the faith. The Church teaches that parents are the primary faith educators of their children, which is a notion I imagine many moms and dads find quite daunting. "Do I need to be coming up with special lesson plans to teach my kids about their faith," some parents might ask. To be sure, there is plenty of media content available intended to help families learn more about their faith at home, like offerings from Relevant Radio and Formed.org, just to name a few. All of our parishioners actually have free access to Formed.org. Just visit the website, click "Sign Up," type "St. Dominic's, Benicia" into the search engine, to obtain this access. We also offer cards in the church vestibule to walk you through this process. More important than showing kids religious media content, however, is that parents simply strive to grow in their faith. Each of us, whether we have kids or not, of course, is called to work at that growth. Growing in our faith requires making time for prayer throughout the week and continuing to learn more about it. I am a big believer that if you are a parent who works at doing that, your faith is bound to become a higher priority and will end up playing more and more of a role in how you lead your family. This is not to say that if you make your faith a top priority in raising your youngsters, they will not drift away from God as adults. Sadly, I have known several very faithful families with kids who did just that. There is no foolproof way to keep your children in the Church because parents do not raise robots, but rather human beings with their own intellects, free will, and susceptibility to temptation. There is a hopeful pattern, however, I have noticed among younger people I have known who returned to the Catholic Faith later in life. Many of them started out in devout families, and the experience of that foundation, even though the kids strayed for a time, left seeds in their souls that sprouted as faith later on down the line. So, never lose heart when you are a parent. Just strive to be a holy family, and leave the rest to God!


