## **Brother's Corner**

Happy Feast of the Baptism of the Lord! Last Sunday was the last of December, which means it would normally have been the day on which I give my "Brother's Report" at the end of Mass, but, as you may have noticed, I was not at St. Dominic's this Sunday. That's because I spent last week at SEEK, a conference for Catholic college students hosted by FOCUS (Fellowship Of Catholic University Students), a national campus ministry organization, in St. Louis, Missouri. Please keep all the students I met in your prayers!

As we re-enter Ordinary Time this week, we are being invited to reflect on what we have received throughout the seasons of Advent and Christmas, and what those gifts mean for us as we now follow Jesus in His ministry. To do that, we can have no better guide than Jesus' own Mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary.

If we see with spiritual eyes, then we know that the Blessed Virgin Mary is the highest honor of the human race, the most favored by God, made completely holy, pure, and beautiful for her unique vocation of bringing God into the world. And yet, to the worldly eyes of flesh, Mary could not be more lowly, more ordinary, more unremarkable. She was a poor peasant girl with no power, no wealth, no high education.

Perhaps this seems like a contradiction, the worldly poverty of Our Lady on the one hand, and her spiritual exaltation on the other. But this is the logic of the Cross, the divine foolishness which is wiser than human wisdom, by which power is manifested in weakness, and glory in humiliation.

In reality, it is exactly the ordinariness of the Blessed Virgin's life which God chose to bless. It was from that humility that her *fiat*, her "yes", came forth which welcomed God into herself. Throughout her life with her divine Son, she remained simple, poor, and lowly, just as Jesus did. She remained close to Him, closer than anyone else, sharing even His Passion as he offered Himself for the world.

Mary shows us the way to be close to Jesus, and it lies, for most of us, not in what is considered exceptional and admirable in the world, but rather in the simplicity and lowliness of daily life. If our lives seem unremarkable and empty, it is only the emptiness of the manger, of the womb, into which Jesus greatly desires to descend, to be present with us and invite us to follow Him. So let us look for him there, in what is lowly. That is where His Mother found Him, and where she waits to reveal Him to us in turn.


